徵稿啟事

1. 研討主旨

隨著地球村的實現，英、日語能力的養成已成為個人和國家不可或缺的競爭力。英、日語教育界在瞬息萬變的大環境中，必須面對衝擊、掌握契機、尋找突破，俾使英、日語教育的品質合乎時代與社會的需求。

全球化下的英、日語教學：

- [1]「專業英、日語教學」：專業英、日語之教學法、教材研發、課程設計，以及著眼於師資培育、教育政策比較等相關研究議題。
- [2]「文化與英、日教學」：文化的層面非常寬廣，是語言學習的根基，也是語言生成的表相。而，異文化交流已為全球化的趨勢，為了解雙方口音的差異，避免文化認知的衝突，從而增強彼此的信賴，亦有待提出鴻文共同討論。
- [3]「E 化英、日語教學」：有關新世代學習風格、策略與學習成效之探討、網路多媒體輔助學習、自主性學習等相關議題，皆可提出深入討論。
- [4]「其他相關議題的英、日語教學」：於全球化下，英、日語教學所面對的相關議題亦歡迎投稿參與研討。

(6). Use one attached format and a copy of manuscript sent to the conference committee
